2012 SWIFT FAMILY HERITAGEORANGE

PRODUCTION NOTE

Shiraz 15%, Cabernet Sauvignon 85%

Casting our minds back almost a decade to the 2012 vintage, it was a cooler vintage than average with a long growing season aiding terrific flavour development. Sourced from the oldest estate vines in the Printhie Winery Block, fermented and then matured in new and one-year-old French and American hogshead barrels and bottled after 15 months.

TASTING NOTE

Typical of a quality wine that has matured well, the colour remains opaque but with red brick hues. There are lifted fruit aromas of bramble and spiced cherry indicating freshness. These are complemented by background savoury oak, leather and freshly turned earth. The palate has nice richness and weight. The tannins are dry but have softened and are fully integrated. Mature and ready to drink.
