Wine Name	Printhie Mountain Range Sauvignon Blanc

Varietal	Sauvignon Blanc 100%
GI	Orange 100%
Vineyard(s)	Wattleview (1100m ASL, 100%)
Key Characteristics	Orange is one of Australia's premier regions for Sauvignon Blanc. Wattleview is one of, if not the highest vineyard in Australia – perfect for sauvignon blanc. Fresh, fruity, intense aromas and flavours and has a distinct regional profile that differs from other notable regions such as Margaret River or Marlborough (NZ).
Production Notes	Single vineyard fruit source. Harvested at peak fruit intensity whilst retain fresh acidity. Clarified juice. Fermented in stainless steel tanks with aromatic yeast at lower temperatures (mid-teens) then letting the temperature to rise late in ferment to produce some thiol aromatics for complexity. Bottled early for freshness.
Tasting Notes	Pale green-yellow colour. Intense varietal aromas – ripe citrus peel plus tropical fruits highlighted by passionfruit, guava and a bit of lychee. The palate has juicy fruit and zingy acidity giving a mouthwatering quality.
Analysis	Alc – 12.2%, pH - 3.28, TA – 8.7gL, RS – 1.5gL
Cellaring	Always best young and fresh.
