Key Characteristics	<p>This is the second release of the Printhie Wattlevue Single Vineyard Pinot Noir. We were keen to explore the differences of site and clone compared to our newer Pinot Noir vineyard (Millwood). There are a couple of key features we aimed for: the wine should taste of Pinot Noir; fruit freshness should be the predominant characteristic with whole bunch, new oak and secondary earthiness should all be in the background; the structure should not be forced, balance and approachability are the key; the wine should be delicious. We paid great respect to the characteristics of the fruit. This wine delivers with a fruit forward approach and underlying intrigue and complexity.</p>
Tasting Notes	<p>Not a dark colour but bright and correct. More obvious aroma than Millwood. Darker cherry fruit, a hint of carbonic confectionery, beetroot and more earthy. The palate is immediately more obvious with good varietal expression and stemmy whole bunch. Finely balanced tannins with a completely different texture and shape to both Millwood and Topography. Very appealing and satisfying.</p>
Analysis	Alc – 12.9%, pH - 3.59, TA – 5.5g/L, RS – 1.7g/L
Cellaring	Medium term cellaring up to 5 years will allow it to gain some additional expressiveness.
